NATIONAL MISSION ON MONSOON

Will the Minister of EARTH SCIENCES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has proposed to establish National Mission on monsoon;
- (b) if so, the salient features of the Mission; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to improve the current statistical model of weather prediction?

- (a)-(b) The Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) has proposed National Mission on Monsoon to develop a representative and advanced dynamic model framework for India for forecasting monsoon rainfall and its variability in various space and time scales.
- (c) Improvement of the current statistical models used for seasonal monsoon prediction is not planned to be part of the Monsoon Mission. However, based on the recommendations of a duly constituted committee, an appropriate work programme is underway for identifying the potential predictors for improving the current suite of statistical models.
